



ANICA CUP – National Tour 2025

REGULATION

1. Conduct and affiliation Show

The ANICA CUP is an event dedicated to Italian Breeders and itinerant at a national level that aims to stimulate and support the participation of Italian Breeders in shows to enhance the production of our farm, promoting maximum visibility and supporting the commitment of Breeders with a dedicated prize money.

The tour will develop during 2025 with **four intermediate stages** identified in **three national C shows** and the final stage organized on the occasion of the **Italian National Championship**.

Below is the list of shows affiliated to the ANICA CUP:

- a. **Parco Vigna Arabians Horse Show** – Carmagnola (TO), *31 May and 1 June 2025*
- b. **Furci Siculo Show Marikshel Arabians** – Furci Siculo (ME), *12 and 13 July 2025*
- c. ****Stage to be defined**** last weekend of July or first weekend of August
- d. **Italian National Championship** – Bedizzole (BS), *13 and 14 September 2025*

To compete for the Final Prize Money, each horse must participate in **at least one of the intermediate stages** on the occasion of the three National C shows and participate in the final Italian National Championship.

2. Conditions of participation of horses

Horses born and bred in Italy **and** owned by ANICA members with Italian citizenship **will be able to participate in the ANICA CUP**. In the event that the horse is owned by a Company, it must have its Registered Office in Italy.

3. Scoring and Rankings

Each horse participating in the individual classes in their respective shows, will accumulate a total score based on the individual placements in its class (in proportion to the number of participants in the class itself) and together with the score accrued from the best placement obtained in the final Championship;

Example score assigned in the category for 5 participating horses

1st place + 5 points – 2nd place + 4 points – 3rd place + 3 points
4th place + 2 points – 5th place + 1 point

Scores awarded during the Championship (in case of more than one medal won during the Tour, only one result will be counted, the best of those obtained)

Gold + 3 points **Silver** + 2 points **Bronze** + 1 point

To form the final ranking of the Anica CUP, the scores obtained in the categories based on the calculation indicated above will be added; the best of the scores obtained during the Final Championships will also be added (e.g. if a horse wins a Gold and two silver medals in the three shows respectively, the score connected to the Gold medal will be considered).

Based on the total scores, the winners will then be announced during the Italian National Championship:

ANICA CUP Champion – Yearling Filly
ANICA CUP Champion – Yearling Colt
ANICA CUP Champion – Junior Filly *
ANICA CUP Champion – Junior Colt *
ANICA CUP Champion – Senior Mare *
ANICA CUP Champion – Senior Stallion*

* in the event of a tie in the final score, the winner will be the subject who has obtained the highest number of medals. In the event of a further tie, the subject with the highest total score in type will win.

In the event that, during the season, the horse changes owner, it may continue its journey while maintaining any points accrued, without prejudice to compliance with the rules provided for Owners referred to in point 2 above. Any assignment of the final prize money won by the horse will be allocated to the actual owner at the time of the end of the tour.

The ECAHO regulations will be applied for all shows.

4. Prize pool

The total prize money for the ANICA CUP is € 22,500.00 and will be divided and assigned as follows:

- *ANICA CUP Final, for each of the six championship categories*

1st place	€ 1.250,00
2nd place	€ 1.000,00
3rd place	€ 750,00
4th place	€ 500,00
5th place	€ 250,00

The awards ceremony will be held on the occasion of the 2025 Italian National Championship. The prizes may be modified at the discretion of ANICA before the final stage"
